Dear Parents & Band Members,

I am looking forward to seeing you all in a few short weeks as we start a very exciting time at the Ohio State Fair. You are all encouraged to spend time with the enclosed pages so you are fully prepared for your time with the All-Ohio State Fair Band.

Check in on July 22

Report to the Rhodes Center at the Ohio Expo Center & Fairgrounds on Saturday, July 22 between 8:30-10:30 am. If you live within 60 miles you are asked to check in by 9:30 am. Please see the enclosed map for directions. Staff will be on hand to assist with parking.

Please leave all belongings in your vehicle until the check in process is complete. After all steps of registration are complete you will move your belongings to your bunk area.

The first rehearsal takes place at 11:00 am and family and friends are invited to attend.

A meeting for ALL parents/families will take place from 11:55-12:15 in the cafeteria. After the meeting concludes you are free to depart for home. Band members will go to lunch and begin placement auditions.

You may write for approval to arrive on Friday, July 21st between the hours of 6:30-8:00 pm only. Early arrival is for extreme conflicts only.

Special Concerts

The AOSFB will be performing away from the fairgrounds at Whetstone Park of Roses on Sunday, July 30 at 7:00 pm. These concerts are free and open to the public. Directions for both venues will be posted on aosfb.com after July 15.



Ohio State Fair Sale of Champions

The event begins at 2:00 pm and usually ends by 4:30 pm, although the end time is flexible. During the Fair, you will be able to cash traveler's checks, money orders, and personal checks at the AOSFB office. There are several ATMs on the Fairgrounds.

The Band will be excused on Saturday, August 5th. The Parents' Concert will be at 1:15 pm in the Rhodes Center - followed by the daily parade at 4:00 pm. The Band will be dismissed after the parade at approximately 4:30 pm. NO ONE will be excused to leave before this time. Please DO NOT ASK and thus save us both the embarrassment. Band members, family and friends are invited to stay and enjoy the Fair after the concert.
